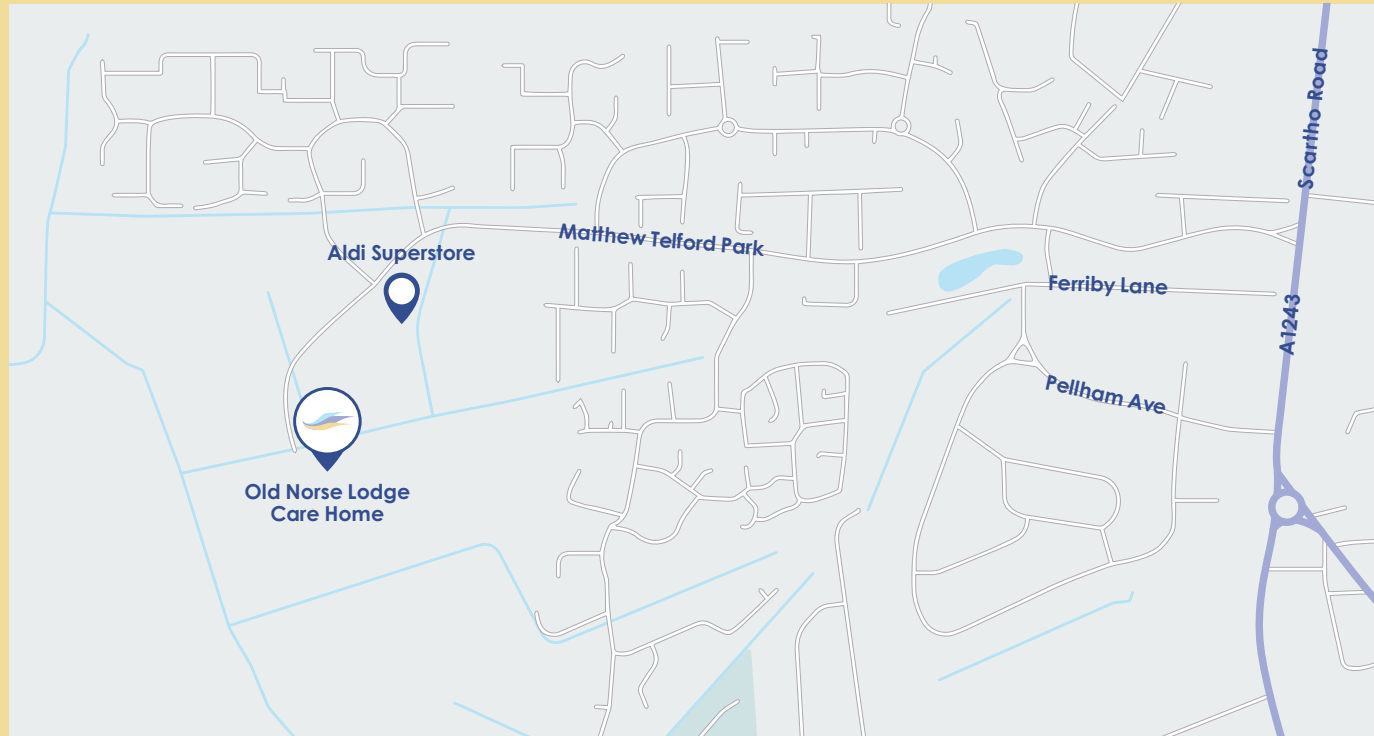

From Scunthorpe, Travelling North or South on the M18 take the M180 leading to the A180 heading towards Great Grimsby. Continue along the A180 passing the Shell petrol station on your right, approach Westgate roundabout taking the 2nd exit on the Westgate. Continue to Lockhill roundabout and take the 3rd exit toward Grimsby town center A16. Continue along the road, go past B&Q on the left continue then turn right at the traffic lights Lincoln A46 on the Weelsby Road. Follow the road then take the left A1243/A46 towards Grimsby Hospital/Boston/Lincoln. Follow the signs for the Hospital, pass the Jet garage on the right side, follow the signs for Kings Park, bus stop on the right shortly afterwards turn right at the traffic lights onto Matthew Telford Park, Scartho Top Road/Superstore. Follow the road towards the Aldi Superstore pass the store and the care home is on your left.

From Lincoln, North on the A16 take the 2nd exit on the Toll Bar roundabout towards Grimsby A16. At Louth Road Roundabout take the 1st exit towards A1243 Grimsby Hospital -Scartho. Carrying along the road you will pass the Rose and Crown pub on your right hand side. At Scartho Fork roundabout take the 2nd exit A1243 Town Centre, follow the road for a short period before passing the bus stop on your lefthand side, at the traffic lights take a left turn onto Matthew Telford Park signposted Scartho Top Road & Superstore. Follow the road towards the Aldi Superstore, pass the store and the care home is on your left.
