Outside, they can enjoy the fresh air on the terrace or stroll around our landscaped gardens, where there's also a pretty summerhouse. The choice is always theirs.












Life at Ardenlea Court

We have two coordinators who plan a range of enjoyable activities, including many for residents who are less mobile. For example:

- painting classes and crafts
- baking sessions
- quizzes and games
- visiting entertainers such as singers and dancers

- pamper sessions, including manicures
