The heart of the National Forest


In the pleasant surroundings of our purpose-built home, we welcome those with a wide range of residential and nursing care needs, including dementia, Huntington's and Parkinson's.

Dementia care

Part of our home, known as Cherry Tree Lane, is dedicated to dementia care. Here, our team help residents to lead a better quality of life.

With the help of their loved ones, we'll build a picture of their life story and their likes and dislikes. Then we can personalise their care and help them live the way they want to.

Nursing care

Nurses are on duty at all times for residents in need of nursing care, which is particularly helpful if their condition requires regular medical attention.



Variety of comfortable bedrooms

We have 57 rooms, four of which are perfect for couples. You can also expect:

- en suite W/C and hand basin
- shared bathrooms around the home
- flat screen TV
- garden view from most rooms. Residents are welcome to bring some personal items from home, like a selection of family photos or their favourite armchair.

- weekly visits from a hairdresser




Shared areas around the home

Our home has a mixture of quiet and social areas to spend time in, including our on-site hair salon every Thursday and several lounges. Residents can even tinkle the ivories on the piano. Those living with dementia can experience our memory lounge, fidget boards, sensory room and reminiscence sessions.

Outside, we have a secure, wheelchair-friendly garden with a patio, fish pond and gazebo. Raised flower beds mean that anyone can do a little gentle gardening in the fresh air.











Life at Ashby Court

We want everyone to find our home enjoyable and stimulating. That's why residents can choose to join in with a range of fun activities. When it's time to eat, residents can sit down for a delicious meal or light snack.



Activities

Our activity coordinators plan a wide variety of things to do, including for those who are less mobile. For example:

- trips to the zoo, shops, cafés, and garden centres
- visits from singers, dance groups and small animals
- arts and crafts, flower arranging, knitting and baking
- bingo, bridge, carpet bowls, and nine-pin bowling outside
- pampering afternoons
- move and groove sessions and wheelchair-friendly gardening
- visits from local children



Residents can continue most of their existing hobbies at Ashby Court. They can also suggest something they'd like to try, as a group or in their room.



Fresh, healthy food

Good food is important, so there are plenty of family favourites on our menu. These can be enjoyed in the dining room or in the comfort of the resident's own room. When the weather's fine, the patio is perfect for tea and biscuits.

When they move in, we talk to each resident about their likes and dislikes and any special dietary requirements.

Meal times

Set meal times ensure that residents can enjoy their food without interruption. If they need to eat at a different time, they can just ask.

Celebrating special occasions

We're happy for families to host events such as birthday parties here. We'll just need to know in advance. Catering can be provided for an additional fee, too.





Visits from family and friends

Family and friends can pop by at any time. If you'll be having a meal with us, just let us know about any dietary needs. If you're visiting the nursing floor, there's a small kitchen for you to use.
