Our team is like family: "They care deeply about our residents and each other."





Excellent homemade meals and engaging activities

Our delicious, home-cooked meals are prepared using fresh, local ingredients. The menu is varied, changing with the seasons, and accommodating the residents' requirements. Afternoon tea includes homemade cake every day. Careful attention is paid to the enjoyment of life and mental health of residents. We have a dedicated activities team who host a range of daily,weekly, and seasonal activities, including art club, games, gentle exercise classes, regular live music, singing and theatre performances. Our notice board in the reception area shows the weekly list of activities. We have no restricted visiting hours during the day and friends and relatives are encouraged to come and enjoy our warm and friendly atmosphere and to share tea or a meal with their loved one. All residents have the opportunity to feedback their views and preferences on all aspects of the home, with emphasis on food and activities, at the monthly Manager's Forum held in the sitting room with a glass of sherry. It is a well-attended, vibrant event which always leads to some positive changes.





Rooms and Garden

Our rooms are individually decorated and furnished in homely, country colours and fabrics. Many of our rooms are significantly larger than average with space to personalise with your own pictures and belongings. All our rooms have ensuite WC facilities and many have their own balcony or patio. Specialist profiling nursing beds and mattresses are standard, along with an upholstered resident's chair and visitor's chair, a touch lamp, smart television, large button private phone and Wi-Fi.

Views from the lounge and dining room are across our own gardens and meadows to the protected South Downs Park beyond which creates a stunning scene in all seasons. Our south- facing terrace creates a lovely suntrap for warmer days with views across the drive and the sunken garden to the village.

We offer care that is professional and welcoming

We provide residential care for those who are more able and independent and nursing care for those with higher needs. We are specialised and experienced in supporting the range of complications of older age such as difficulty with independent living, care for general frailty, respiratory, neurological and cardiac conditions, and palliative care.

Permanent Residential Care

Our rooms and home are designed to maximise your independence whilst removing the burden of domestic responsibilities with 24-hour care assistance and support. Some of our residents still continue with the regular features of their calendars while at Alfriston Court.

Permanent Nursing Care

We provide 24-hour onsite nursing care. We use advanced care planning to ensure the most accurate and responsive approach to all our residents' needs.

Respite Nursing Care

Respite care is two or more weeks of 24hour nursing care and support, enabling the resident's usual carer to have some much-needed rest and relaxation.

What Types of Condition Do We Support?

This might be frailty associated with oldage, managing after a stroke or a heart condition, and those with declining health for example Parkinson's or cancer. Care plans are personalised with the input of health specialists such as physiotherapy. We provide 24-hour palliative care for those with cancer and other terminal conditions. It is a privilege to support the person and their family and friends in what is an extremely difficult time.
