Plus, for an additional cost, residents can benefit from:

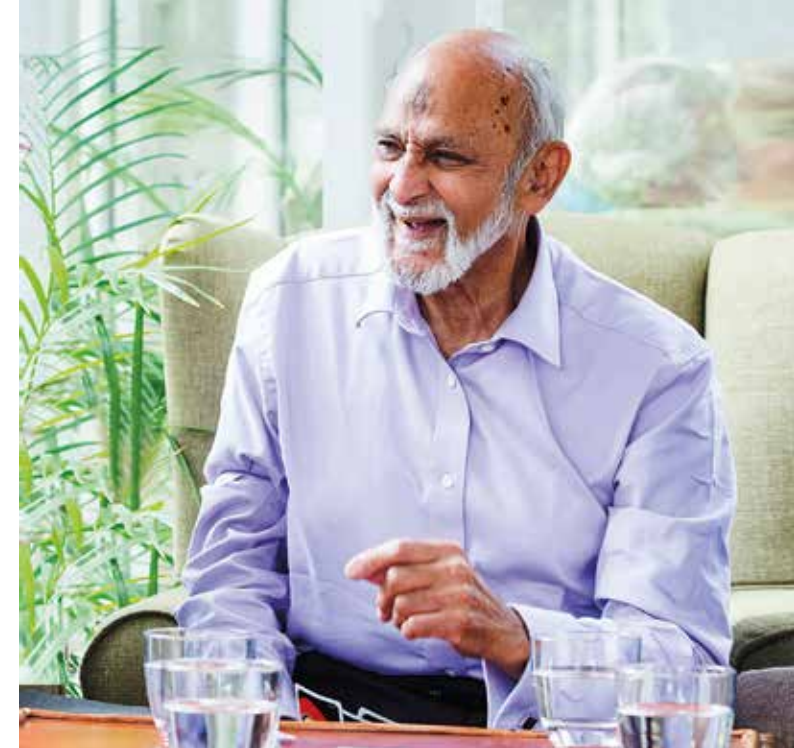
