Nursing care

Nurses are on duty at all times for residents in need of nursing care, which is particularly helpful if their condition requires regular medical attention.



Variety of comfortable bedrooms

We have 38 lovely rooms for those in need of nursing care, and 19 residential suites in Newdale Court. Inside, you can expect:

- en suite W/C in most rooms (some with a shower, too)
- shared bathrooms around
- a garden view from many rooms
- patio doors in a handful of rooms
- flat screen TV
- optional telephone point (bills payable)

Residents are welcome to bring some small personal items from home, like pictures and ornaments.



Services available to all

- Advice from a nutritionist
- Visits from district nurses
- Pet therapy
- Religious services
- Wifi throughout the home
- Laundry and cleaning

Shared areas around the home

You'll find a mixture of both spacious and cosy spaces to relax here. Residents can sit down with a good book in one of our three lounges or have their nails and hair done in our beauty salon.

Outside, our extensive grounds are perfect for a gentle stroll, a bit of light gardening or sitting watching the visiting wildlife. During the summer months, we often serve afternoon tea on the patio.

- village events like Stockfest (we enter a scarecrow every year)
