We offer residential care for up to 19 individuals as well as day care and respite.

Beautiful and cosy Edwardian home

Grangefield Care Home offers a cosy atmosphere within a beautifully styled Edwardian home. We take great pride in our how our home and garden looks. When you walk in you will find the home to be clean and well maintained. Our décor is warm and inviting with a stylish flair.

We have two elegant lounges as well as a conservatory. Our dining room is housed in a purpose-built Orangery, which boasts a large skylight and bi-folding doors that lead out onto our courtyard garden.

Most of the bedrooms have en-suite toilets and some have walk in shower facilities. The majority of the bedrooms can be found on the ground floor and have doors leading out onto the courtyard garden.

The garden is maintained all year round. Standing proudly in the centre is a large, hand built wooden Pergola. This provides much needed shade to our clients during those long and lazy Summer afternoons. On either side of the Pergola sit flower beds with David Austin roses. These provide intense colour and a sweet scent throughout the Spring and Summer months. The garden also has a long row of English Lavender, potted plants and a therapeutic water feature.



Tailored cuisine

Clients can get up whenever they want. We do not rush them. We fit in around our clients, not the other way around.

For breakfast, clients can have whatever they want from a full English breakfast to poached eggs or just tea and toast.

For Lunch, we have a seasonal menu that relies on locally sourced fresh fruit and vegetables. On a daily basis, our cook visits every client and discusses the day's menu. Should they not like what is on the menu then an alternative meal is prepared for them.

For Supper, clients again have a choice of what they want to eat. Mid-morning and mid-afternoon, tea and cake is served. In the evening before bed, refreshments are offered such as Horlicks and biscuits.



In-house bar

We have our very own in-house bar called The Residents Arms. Clients are free to have a drink at any time. A number of our clients will have a glass (or two!) of wine with their meals.

Social activities & events

We like to provide a range of activities to keep our residents busy. This includes arts & crafts, bridge, bingo or pub-style quizzes. We regularly have people coming in to entertain our residents, such as singers and sports therapists. We also celebrate every client's birthday with gifts, flowers and a cake.

In Summer, we host events at which we invite our clients' friends and families. We also have a range of outdoor activities such 'pet-an-animal' and garden games.

Once a quarter, we host a 'relatives forum' to discuss our plans and to give relatives an opportunity to ask questions and make suggestions.

Cutting-edge technology

We use a range of cutting-edge technology to help us deliver a better service to our clients.

This includes a care planning system that uses hand-held devices. Each client's care plan is individual to them and the devices tell our Carers exactly what to do for each client. If the needs of a client changes, then we can immediately re-programme the devices to reflect the new changes. This way, clients receive accurate, on-time care.



We also use a sophisticated medication system that is linked to our pharmacy.

This allows us to implement the latest prescription changes, whilst keeping a real-time log and stock of medications.

Additionally, we use a wireless nursecall system. This system provides a flexible and user-friendly call bell system for our clients.

All-inclusive service

Unlike other care homes we do not charge 'extra' for certain services. Our fees are inclusive of hairdressing, chiropody and all activities & events.

Day care

Day care clients can enjoy companionship and being pampered in the comforts of our beautiful home.

We offer a 10-hour day care session that includes all meals, tea & cake, daily activities and drinks from our in-house bar.

We can also arrange for one of our carer's to pick you up and drop you back home.

Our homecare service is small and personal.

We do not take on large, multiple-client care contracts and instead serve a small group of individual clients. We also only cover a small geographic area, which includes Earls Barton and the surrounding towns and villages.

By not taking on too many clients and covering just a small area, we are able to provide a reliable, on-time and personal service.

Having a small team of hand-picked local carers means they are able to build strong relationships with our clients, who benefit from having the 'same faces' each visit.

Also, since the operation is run by Grangefield Care Home, our homecare clients have access to services such as day care. Additionally, we can deliver cooked meals from Grangefield Care Home.
