Field House Care Home is situated in Harborne, West Midlands, providing residential care for over 65's. A change of use of the premises in 1984 established a care home and the current Provider took the home back to its original name of Field House Residential Home in 2014. The house was built in 1870 and its Grade 2 Listed.



The total accommodation is spread over three floors of this period property, with a passenger lift available to access each floor. The home is made up of a composite of varying sized rooms, to accommodate a mixture of needs. We are registered to care for 21 residents and have 20 single bedrooms, one can be occupied as a double for siblings or married couples. The bedrooms are a mixture of sizes, x16 have an en suite facility, and some have showers too.

Field House is family run and we have a wonderful team who work tirelessly to care for our residents how we would want our loved ones cared for. A senior team member takes charge of each shift and has the support of other team members and ourselves.

SOCIALISING AND ACTIVITIES

Field House is your home and as such we welcome you to have your family and friends visit at any time. You can entertain visitors in your bedroom or enjoy catching up in our quiet lounge. Our residents are free to come and go, often joining friends and family on adventures, meals out and holidays. At Field House, we encourage our residents to pursue their hobbies and interests. For instance, if you enjoy gardening, you can adopt an area of the garden to tend to or you can help grow your own vegetables in our in-house vegetable patch! There are plenty of local activities that you can get involved with in the local community, such as art classes or jazz evenings. We have a great rapport with the local churches, and they attend the home to deliver services monthly and they also hold a weekly holy communion. Additionally, we have visits from the local school fortnightly and a monthly visit from the local mother and toddler group. Field House holds daily activities for our residents in the morning and the afternoon, we also provide a weekly external exercise session and regular entertainment sessions from a local singer.

FACILITIES AND SERVICES

Field House premises include hairdressing facilities, we have regular visits from healthcare professionals such as district nurses and occupational therapists, all free of charge. Additional costs include chiropody who visits every 8 weeks and an annual visit from the opticians and dentist. If you are an avid newspaper reader, relatives can arrange for newspapers to be delivered to Field House daily. Field House provides free Wi-Fi and smart televisions in every room that allow for Netflix and other streaming services. We offer virtual visits to relatives also via FaceTime, WhatsApp and Zoom.

All food is cooked fresh on site by the Chef, Cook and kitchen team and is home made with local ingredients and home grown produce from our vegetable patch. There is an option for families to come and enjoy afternoon tea on the first Thursday of every month, at a small cost that goes towards our entertainment fund, this includes a pot of tea, fingerless sandwiches, scones, and cake. We encourage families to join their relative for Sunday lunch in their relative's bedroom or the visitors lounge, this can be arranged with the Care Manager, at an additional cost.

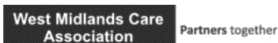
