- on-site hairdresser and beautician




Shared areas around the home

There are lots of places to relax inside our home. These include our own hair salon, several lounges where residents can find company or a bit of quiet time, and a bistro and activity room.


Outside are lovely gardens with mature trees, backing onto open fields. We have a sensory garden at the back, and the secure front garden has a patio area.

We have several dining areas where families can host private events such as birthday parties. We'll just need to know in advance. Plus, we can arrange catering for an additional fee.






Visits from family and friends
