Activities

Our team of coordinators plan enjoyable things to do for all our residents, seven days a week, including for those who are less mobile. These include:

- walks along the wheelchair-friendly canal paths

- visiting entertainers

There are plenty of favourites on the menu, but we also talk to each resident when they move in about their likes, dislikes, and any special dietary needs.
