

Paying For Your Care

When making a decision about a care home, often one of the biggest concerns is how to pay for care.

Our weekly fees are dependent on the type of room and the level of care required. A full preadmission care needs assessment will determine the level of care that needs to be put in place. The fee will be confirmed by our home manager, and we will always strive to be transparent with all our costs to help with the decision-making process.

Details of our weekly starting fees and what's included in our prices has been included within this pack.

Local Authority Financial Support

Depending on where you live, you may find you are eligible for some care home costs to be paid by your Local Authority. We can point you in the right direction, but it will be your responsibility to agree on the funding with the Local Authority.

If the Local Authority is unable to meet our fee level, a third-party top-up may be required. We will assist in any way we can, but ultimately, if the Local Authority is unable to secure the required funding level for our fees, then you will need to seek an alternative care option.

It's important to fully understand how care funding works, and we recommend seeking professional advice to make sure you have explored all the options available to you.
