Dementia care

We have a specialist dementia floor, with a dedicated team who can help residents lead a better quality of life. They're trained to focus on the person first and their condition second. We also have lots of stimulating sensory areas, including a garden and a calming space which plays gentle music.

Nursing care

Nurses are on duty at all times for residents in need of nursing care, which is particularly helpful if their condition requires regular medical attention.

Fresh, healthy food

Our chef prepares delicious meals which are served to residents by friendly hostesses. Residents can enjoy their food in one of our social dining areas, or have it delivered to their room. There are plenty of favourites on the menu, and we also add in a bit of fun with themed nights.

We talk to each resident when they move in about their likes, dislikes, and any special dietary needs.

Meal times

Set meal times allow residents to enjoy their food without interruption but if they'd prefer to eat at a different time, that's okay. We also have a night-time snack menu.

Families are welcome to reserve our beautiful sea-view café, on the top floor, to host private events such as birthday parties. We can arrange catering for an additional fee.
