Located on the ground floor and with access to a beautiful landscaped central garden, Foxglove and Bluebell Communities provide a choice of attractive day rooms where Residents can enjoy social encounters or a quiet place to read the newspaper or enjoy breakfast, lunch or dinner in our elegant dining room.

On more pleasant days they can take a sojourn into the garden for an enjoyable alfresco dining experience or simply a relaxing snooze in the sun on the terrace.

Residents' bedrooms are beautifully decorated and furnished to the highest of standards and some offer patio doors, leading to a small but perfectly formed private patio; a lovely place to keep an eye
