The most important aspect of dementia care is that it should first and foremost be personal. Our Homes have a dedicated dementia offering to support those with dementia to live well.

What is dementia?

Dementia occurs when the brain is affected by a disease. It is not a natural part of ageing; however, the chance of developing dementia increases significantly with age. There are more than 100 known causes of dementia. The most known types are Alzheimer's and Vascular Dementia.

Whilst memory loss is a symptom of dementia, the condition damages different areas of the brain and leads to a variety of challenging symptoms. It affects all the senses, and because it is so complex, every person's experience of it is unique.

We are here to support you

Personalised expert care

We get to know each resident's past and their present to create a Care Plan as individual as they are. We consider your loved one's care needs whilst respecting preferences, lifestyle, interests, and routines.

We have specific floors that cater for different dementia needs - from the early signs of dementia through to behaviour that challenges and end of life care.

Encore has a dementia dedicated Clinical Leadership Team supported by skilled care experts, from Home Managers to Clinical Leads and Senior Nurses.

A full assessment of each resident's care needs is completed to establish the exact care requirements of the individual. This is continually reviewed, with input from relatives, to ensure we always provide the highest standard of care.

Residents/relatives complete a This Is Me document, which allows all staff members to get to know every resident (past and present) and understand their likes, dislikes, and their preferences.

Compulsory dementia training

Not only do we ensure ongoing training for all our staff but we also provide coaching and mentoring to ensure that every member of the team understands the needs of the residents and how to best care for them.

As part of their induction and training when they join Encore Care Homes, our team members benefit from learning about dementia and its effects. This compulsory dementia training teaches staff how to communicate with individuals with dementia and support them to live well. It teaches them how to use person-centred approaches to care for those with behaviour that challenges.

Additionally, all our team members take part in what is proven to be the closest experience to what it is like for an individual to live with dementia.

The ground-breaking Virtual Dementia Tour run by Experience Training Ltd, the organisation of evidence-based training to care providers, is the only medically and scientifically proven method for a healthy brain to encounter what life is truly like for mid-range Alzheimer's patients.

We arrange for all our team members to take part in this training as it is vital to enable our caregivers to identify with and better understand the behaviours and needs of those in our care. Subsequently, they are empowered with the knowledge and compassion to better communicate with, and support our residents.

The vital training that we provide enables our teams to support person-centred care and positive communication; so that families can feel reassured that their loved ones will be understood, treated with respect and dignity, and that they will feel comfortable and happy in their surroundings.

Homely environments

Another crucial element of dementia care is providing a familiar, safe environment that eradicates frustrations and puts you at ease. Encore homes are purpose-built to be dementia-friendly from every aspect – from the layout of the building to sensitive décor and interior design.

Stress levels of those living with dementia can be heighten by their surroundings. We reduce the

effects of stress, such as agitation, sleeplessness, wandering and aggression, with our homely environments, which consider colour, lighting, layout, noise, and access to space and gardens - ensuring residents living with dementia feel at home and comfortable.

The interior styling encourages conversation and engagement. The acoustics are kept to a soft minimum, which has proven to have a beneficial effect on the residents' mental health and behaviour. We also monitor the noise levels to research the impact on our residents.

We continually evaluate and strive to improve our environments based on the individuals that reside with us and their changing needs. Whilst considering residents' care requirements, wishes and history, we adapt and refresh our resources to provide innovative and imaginative ways to further comfort residents and help them to feel at home – one size does not fit all.

All residents are encouraged to bring their own possessions, mementos, and photos to help trigger happy memories. At the entrance of each bedroom there are purpose-built memory boxes for residents to display some of these items.



Sensory Gardens

Our landscaped gardens promote reminiscence and activity. We have designed them with all the seasons in mind. The flora and fauna have been carefully selected to provide tactile textures as well as colour to engage the senses and encourage residents to touch, smell and enjoy the array of hues.

The gardens have been specifically designed with a walking 'flow' to provide residents with a continual walk around the garden if they wish and avoiding abrupt ends to paths.

All Encore gardens have raised flower beds, which residents are encouraged to tend to, should they so desire, or to simply enjoy the flowers, vegetables and herbs, which are made more accessible for residents to touch and appreciate.

As well as various quiet areas of the garden that residents and families can sit to enjoy the tranquillity and birdsong in peace, our courtyards are designed with a more inclusive layout. They lend themselves to social gatherings with other residents and team members, as well as providing the perfect acoustic stage for outdoor entertainment.

Nutrition

Our professional chefs provide freshly prepared 3-course meals, which are nutritional, balanced, delicious, and appetising. Our seasonal and varied menus are created using locally sourced food. Our in-house professional chefs speak to every resident and refer to their This Is Me document to ensure that favourite meals are incorporated into the inclusive menus.

The dishes are capable of being adapted to suit all palates, including soft food diets. For those that require soft foods or are on a puree diet, our chefs use a variety of techniques, including piping and moulds to reconstruct the individual foods and textures, and recreate the dish on the plate. We believe that the food experience should remain appetising and enjoyed by all residents, and we endeavour to make mealtimes something to look forward to for everyone.

Light meals and snacks are always available throughout the day so that residents, especially those with dementia, can eat when they feel like it, not just at set mealtimes. Residents are free to eat in their rooms or enjoy the company of others in the dining rooms.

Devoted Wellbeing Team

We have a dementia trained Wellbeing Team in every home. The teams create and deliver carefully tailored activity programmes, which incorporate personalised aspects and residents' preferences – and consider the impact of dementia.

Dementia affects the entire person – mind, body, emotions and spirit. All activities are designed to have a therapeutic and mentally stimulating influence, and we encourage those living with dementia to actively get involved.

Activities on our dementia floors vary from group activities to more personalised one-to-one activities. The team speaks to every resident and family to find out about each person's interests and hobbies. Depending on the resident's care needs, the Wellbeing team find creative ways to adapt activities and promote an inclusive environment that engages residents in subjects they take pleasure in. These personalised activities form part of the daily activities offered.

For those residents that prefer or require more one-toone engagement, our Wellbeing staff take time with individuals, whether it is guiding them in activities, or simply spending some time talking with residents, and reassuring them with a gentle hand on theirs.

Palliative Care

We listen to your wishes and are here to support you and your loved ones. Palliative care is for those who are in the last months or years of life.

If you, or your loved one has an incurable illness, palliative care manages the pain and other afflicting symptoms.

Our end of life care enables us to help you, or your loved one to live as comfortably as possible and to ensure, without compromise, that you, or your loved one passes away with respect and dignity.

Respectful

We take your hopes and preferences into account when working with you, or your loved one, to create a care plan that is unique and right for the individual.

We provide not only physical support but also psychological, social and spiritual support for the resident, as well as their family.

If there are vacant rooms available, these are offered at no cost to family members who wish to stay overnight with loved ones in their final days.

Planning for end of life

Anyone can plan for their future care, whether they are ill or not. However, if you, or your loved one has a terminal illness, it can be comforting and reassuring to make plans together for end of life care.

This is sometimes called advance care planning and helps to talk about your wishes for how you or your loved one are taken care of in the final months of life.


Some degenerative conditions mean that communication can become very hard towards the end, therefore, by preparing for end of life care, your decisions and feelings about your future can be listened to and planned for.

Respite Care

We offer flexible, temporary care when you need it most. We work with you to tailor the care you, or your loved one may need during your stay with us.

Every Encore Care Home has been designed to provide residents with a comfortable and relaxing stay whether on a short-term break or as a permanent resident.

Our respite care availability is on a home-by-home basis, and is from two to six weeks. Our modern, purpose-built care homes have been specifically designed with caregiving in mind and you, or your loved one will receive a personalised care plan during your stay, however long or short.

Temporary care when you need it most

Respite for carers

We appreciate that full-time carers who look after a family member or friend may need a break, or just need some additional help from time to time. The care we offer our short-term residents is the same high-quality standard that our permanent residents receive. Therefore, you can be reassured that your loved one will continue to be well looked after during this time.

On the road to recovery

If you, or a loved one, has had an operation, or has been unwell and needs a place to stay whilst you recover, we can provide you with the extra assistance you require. During your stay of convalescence, we can help with the day-to-day aspects until you are able to return to your own home.

Finding the right home for you

Choosing the right home is a big decision. You can stay on a respite basis for up to 6 weeks before you make the commitment to stay; providing a chance for residents to settle and get to know friendly faces.


