Set in a tranquil village



We're a short distance from the centre of Huddersfield, where residents can tour the local parks or ride a steam train at Kirklees Light Railway. Just 200 yards from our door is the Lindley Clock Tower, an Art Nouveau monument.



Our care team

We're all highly trained in providing 24-hour tailored care here. We get to know each resident personally, so we can make sure we get the balance between support and independence just right. This provides peace of mind for families and a safe and comfortable home for residents.



What we offer

Each of our residents are cared for with kindness and respect, whether they're joining us for a week to give their family some respite or starting a new chapter in their life. We do everything we can to look after their wellbeing, always focusing on the person first and their condition second.

Nursing care

Nurses are on duty at all times, which is particularly helpful if their condition requires regular medical attention.

Dementia support

Our specialists can help residents to lead a better quality of life. With the help of their loved ones, we'll build a picture of their life story and their likes and dislikes. Then we can personalise their care and help them live the way they want to.



Variety of comfortable bedrooms

We have 40 lovely rooms, three of which are large enough for couples to share. You can also expect:

- en suite WC and hand basin
- shared bathrooms
- a garden view from many rooms
- option to add a TV.

Residents are encouraged to bring some familiar possessions from home to help them settle in.



Services available to all

- GP visits and clinics within the home
- Dentist visits
- Advice from a nutritionist
- On-site hairdresser
- Religious services
- Wifi throughout the home
- Laundry and cleaning

Plus, for an additional cost, residents can benefit from:

- chiropody
- eye care from an optician.



Shared areas around the home

There are plenty of places to relax here. We have two quiet lounges, plus two additional lounges where residents can take part in a range of activities. For those who enjoy a good pamper session, they can use our on-site salon.

Outside, we have wheelchairfriendly paths so everyone can enjoy our gardens. There's also a front and rear patio, both great for sitting with visiting family when the weather's nice.











Life at Lindley Grange

We want our residents to love being here. That's why everyone gets a say in how they spend their time. From socialising in the dining room over a hot meal to choosing a group or one-to-one activity.



Activities

Our coordinator plans a range of engaging things for residents to do every day of the week, including for those who are less mobile. Activities include:

- gentle armchair exercises
- walks to the local duck pond and village
- arts and crafts, bingo and reading
- visiting entertainers like singers
- music therapy every Friday
- day trips to Blackpool and the set of Emmerdale
- awareness events like Alzheimer's walks
- regular visits from a local nursery group.



Residents can continue to enjoy most of their existing hobbies here or suggest something new they'd like to try. We also have strong links with the local community.



Fresh, healthy food

Our tempting meals and snacks can be enjoyed in one of our dining areas or in the comfort of the resident's room. Each month we have a themed meal, covering lots of key dates in the calendar.

We also talk to each resident about their likes, dislikes and any special dietary needs when they move in. That way we can cook their food just right.

Meal times

Set meal times ensure that residents can enjoy their food without interruption. If they'd prefer to eat at a different time, that's okay, too.

Celebrating special occasions

Our quiet lounges can be used to host small family events, like birthday parties. We'll just need to know in advance. For a donation, we'd happily arrange some catering for up to 10 people.






Visits from family and friends
