Over recent years, Chris noticed that the idea of retirement villages was already gathering steam in America: communities developed for everyone over a certain age that wanted to live with other, like-minded people of similar ages and passions. As the idea journeyed 'across the pond', retirement villages sprang up in the UK too, and today they have become a massive part of the construction and housing sector in their own right. However, so far, the vast majority of them seem to be created for people who, for example, are in their mid-50s, and want to get out of the hustle and bustle of everyday life by settling into tranquil surroundings that retirement communities bring. They wish for everything to be on their doorstep to create a sustainable lifestyle away from the crowds, but have the ability to go out and about when they wish to do so. What is wrong with that? Nothing!

However, what happens then? What happens when we get older? What happens when we get sick? Or disabled? Or worse? Some care villages have a modicum of close care on site for when residents begin to get the inevitable features of aging that we will all have to face at some point, but what happens when the care need becomes too great for the community to cope with?
