# Live In Care...What is it?

Live In care refers to a full-time care service where a professional Live In Carer resides with the individual in need of care in their own home. The Live In Carers assist with various activities of daily living such as personal hygiene, medication management, meal preparation, housekeeping, mobility assistance, and companionship.

This service is especially beneficial for elderly individuals, those with chronic illnesses, or people with disabilities who require constant monitoring and assistance but wish to maintain their independence and stay in their familiar environment. Live In Care ensures the individual's safety, comfort, and health by providing personalised care and an immediate response to any emergencies that may arise.

## Contact

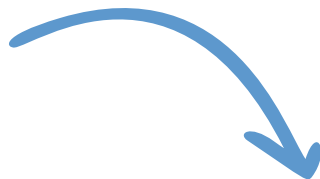
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## Assessment
