




Shared areas around the home


There are lots of places to seek out company or relax here.
Residents can have their hair done, see a movie on the cinema screen, or curl up with a book in our quiet lounge beneath the glass dome.


Outdoors, our large landscaped grounds are perfect for a stroll. There's an ornamental fishpond, a putting and bowling green, and an inviting terrace with seating.

Set meal times ensure that residents can enjoy their food without interruption. If they'd prefer to eat at a different time, that's okay, too.


Celebrating special occasions


Families are welcome to host private dining for events such as birthday parties. Please let us know about your plans in advance, and we can arrange catering for an additional fee.
