Set in superb private grounds


In a beautiful spot close to the edge of the Peak District, we welcome those in need of a range of residential and nursing care, including palliative and Parkinson's care.


Shared areas around the home

We're a small and sociable community, where every resident is valued and appreciated. We're strong on activities, and our newsletter and photo board keep everyone up to date with what's going on.




Our full-time activity coordinators plan enjoyable things to do, including for those who are less mobile. For example:

Celebrating special occasions


We have a lounge where families are welcome to host private events such as birthday parties. We'll just need to know in advance. Plus, we can arrange catering for an additional fee.
