# Unique family atmosphere


We offer a warm welcome to anyone in need of residential or nursing care. Here residents can expect to find friendship, a choice of stimulating activities and quality care, all under one roof.

# What we offer

Looking after our residents' wellbeing is important. That's why we do everything we can to help each person settle in as soon as possible. Whether that's by arranging something interesting to do in our activities room or helping them add some personal touches to their bedroom.

#### Nursing care

Nurses are on duty at all times for residents in need of nursing care, which is particularly helpful if their condition requires regular medical attention.



### Variety of comfortable bedrooms

Outdoors, we have a beautiful courtyard garden with raised beds and colourful mobiles (hand-made by our own residents). There's plenty of seating on the patio at the back, too.









# Life at Maypole

There's a real focus on doing what you love here. We're happy for residents to share their thoughts on everything, from the type of activities they'd like to do, to where and when they'd like to eat their food. It's what gives our home that welcoming feeling.



### Activities

We have two dedicated activity coordinators who arrange a weekly plan of interesting things to do, including for those who are less mobile. Activities include:

- quiz, bingo and movie nights
- arts and crafts, baking and games
- visits from a 'zoo lab' (everything from snakes to hamsters)
- chair-based exercise classes
- themed events, like Rock 'n' Roll nights
- visits from a children's music group, the Jiggy Wrigglers



Residents can continue to enjoy most of their existing hobbies at Maypole. And they can always suggest something they'd like to try, as a group or in their room.



### Fresh, healthy food

There's never a shortage of favourite foods on our menu. Residents can choose to have their meal in one of our social dining areas or in the comfort of their room. And if they fancy a light snack, we offer a variety of cold food, from sandwiches to sweet treats.

When residents move in, we talk to each of them about their likes, dislikes and any special dietary needs.
