Our single-storey home, surrounded by well-maintained secure gardens and patio areas, sits in the leafy residential area of Penketh in Warrington and overlooks a meadow, which regularly has horses grazing.

Meadowview Care Home was originally part of a school site. The home is now its own separate building, however the strong connection between older and younger generations remains. We host intergenerational events that are a delight to our residents and the school community alike. The primary school is still next door to our home, sharing the same access drive and bringing the joyful sound of children playing to our residents.

Wholesome dining

Nutrition and hydration are an important aspect of our care and your loved one will enjoy wholesome and tasty home-cooked meals, freshly prepared by our dining team. For our residents living with dysphagia, the same quality meals are pureed yet presented perfectly. Every meal includes fresh ingredients, and local produce, whenever possible.

Hot and cold drinks are available any time of the day or night and our residents can also enjoy mid-morning and mid-afternoon freshly-baked cakes and biscuits.



Tailor-made activities

Physical and mental activities are important for cognitive health, and we encourage residents to get involved in our daily activities.

Based on personal care plans, meaningful activities such as games, exercises, music and art are organised by our dedicated activities coordinators. If your loved one enjoys gardening, they can spend time pottering in our secure gardens and patio areas.

For our residents that are able and choose to join us on excursions, our minibus makes trips out to nearby attractions, shopping and garden centres.

Throughout the year we enjoy intergenerational events with the two neighbouring primary schools, which brings joy to both our residents and the school children.
