Plus, for an additional cost, residents can benefit from:

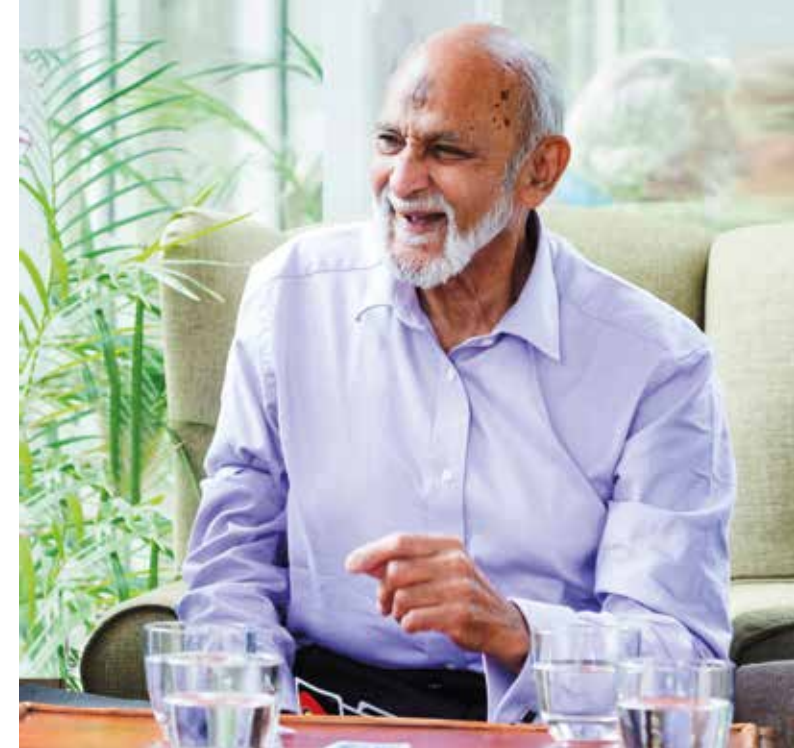

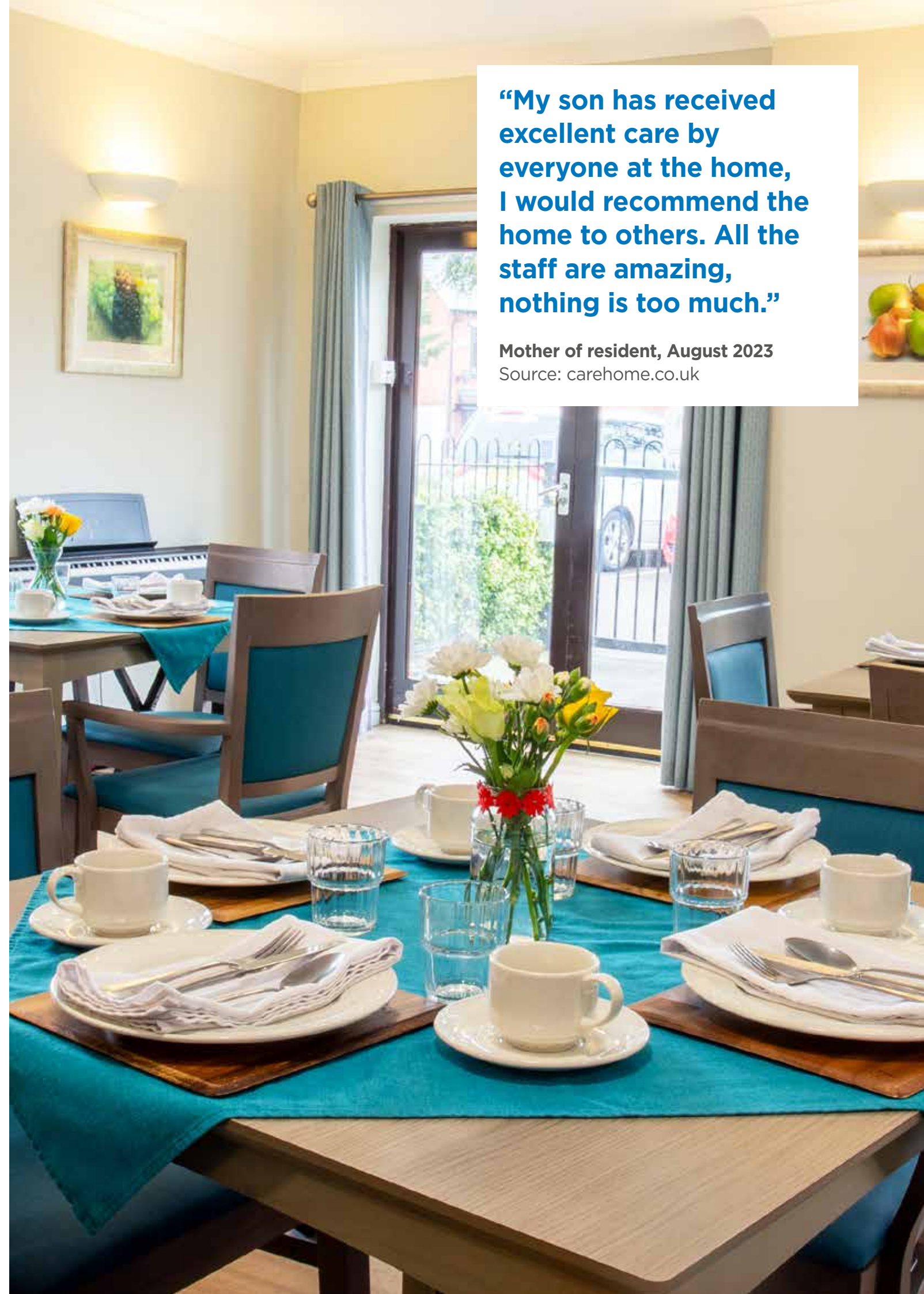
Visits from family and friends
