
Our stylish, purpose-built home is situated in the peaceful residential area of Bitterne. Here, we warmly welcome those living with dementia in need of nursing or palliative care.

Dementia support

Our specialists can help residents with dementia to lead a better quality of life. With the help of their loved ones, we'll build a picture of their life story, likes and dislikes. Then we can personalise their care and help them live the way they want to.

Nursing care

Nurses are on duty at all times for residents in need of nursing care, which is particularly helpful if their condition requires regular medical attention.



Variety of comfortable bedrooms

We have 71 lovely rooms, split across four floors – all easily accessible by lift. You can also expect:

- en suite W/C and shower
- shared bathrooms around the home
- a garden view from most rooms
- telephone point (bills payable)

Residents are also encouraged to bring some familiar, treasured items from home, like pictures and keepsakes.



Services available to all

Residents can relax in a number of places here. We have at least one lounge on every floor, a designated quiet area and a hair salon - ideal for those who enjoy a good pamper session.

Outside, we have a sensory and flower garden and a conservation area. Residents can enjoy a stroll around our lovely gardens, or take a seat when the weather's nice.

Great food, stimulating activities and lovely company help everyone to feel at home. We're always asking residents what they'd like to do, and are happy to support them in any way we can. If ever they'd like some quiet time, that's okay, too.



Activities

Our coordinator plans activities based on residents' interests, and likes to get everyone involved, including those who're less mobile. Activities include:

- movie afternoons
- animal experiences with snakes, owls and lambs
- days out
- visiting entertainers like line dancers and singers
- social tea dances
- light exercises with hoops and balls
- gardening club
- visits from local nursery groups



Residents can continue to enjoy most of their existing hobbies here. And they can always suggest something they'd like to try, as a group or in their room.



Fresh, healthy food

Our chef prepares tempting and nutritious meals for residents to enjoy in our social dining room or in the comfort of their own room. We also do special dishes for themed days like Chinese New Year.

Celebrating special occasions


We're happy for families to host small events like birthday parties at our home. We'll just need to know in advance. Catering is available for a small fee per person, too.
