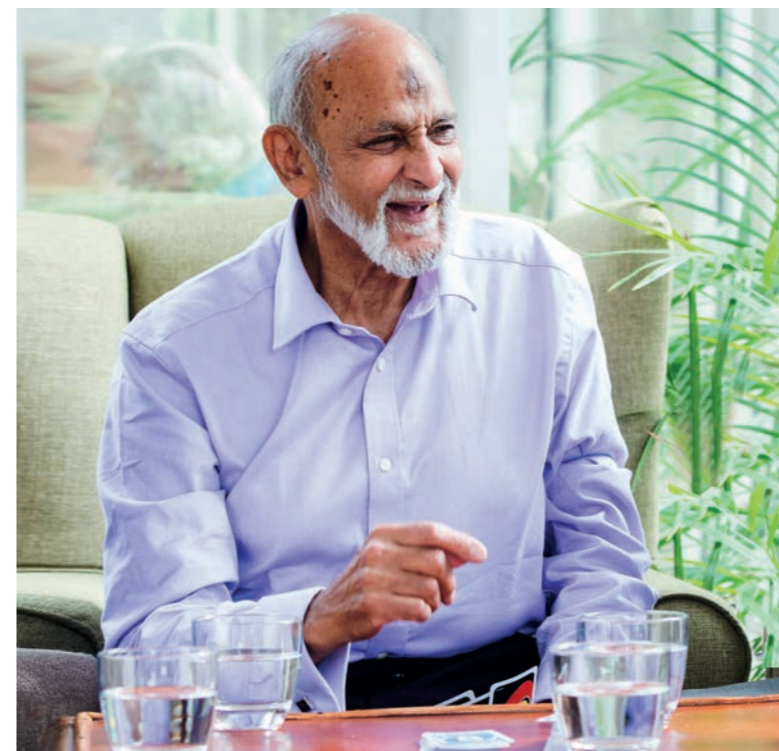

Sutton Lodge is a beautiful period building and part of it is Grade II listed. Although it's been modernised to offer every convenience, there are still lots of original features. Lovely surroundings inside and out, plus high quality care, make this a very special place to be.

Nursing care

Nurses are on duty at all times for residents in need of nursing care, which is particularly helpful if their condition requires regular medical attention.



Variety of comfortable bedrooms

We have 25 pretty rooms, some with garden views and two of which are ideal for couples. You can also expect:

- en suite WC in most rooms
- shared bathrooms around the home
- flat screen TV
- telephone point (bills payable)

Residents are welcome to bring personal items from home, such as pictures and knick-knacks.



Services available to all

- GP visits within the home or at the practice
- Advice from a dietitian
- Visits from specialist nurses including Parkinson's, MS, palliative and tissue viability
- Pet therapy
- Religious services
- Wifi throughout the home

Shared areas around the home

We have plenty of inviting shared spaces at Sutton Lodge. There's a homely lounge which leads into the sunny conservatory where residents can relax with a good book. An activities room with a dedicated hair and beauty area. Plus, a well-decorated reception which has a small play area for visiting children.

Outside, residents can stroll around our large garden and watch the water feature. Our raised flower beds offer the chance to do a little gentle gardening, and there's a seating area where everyone can enjoy the fresh air.

We're happy for families to host small events such as birthday parties here. We'll just need to know in advance. Plus we can arrange catering for an additional fee.

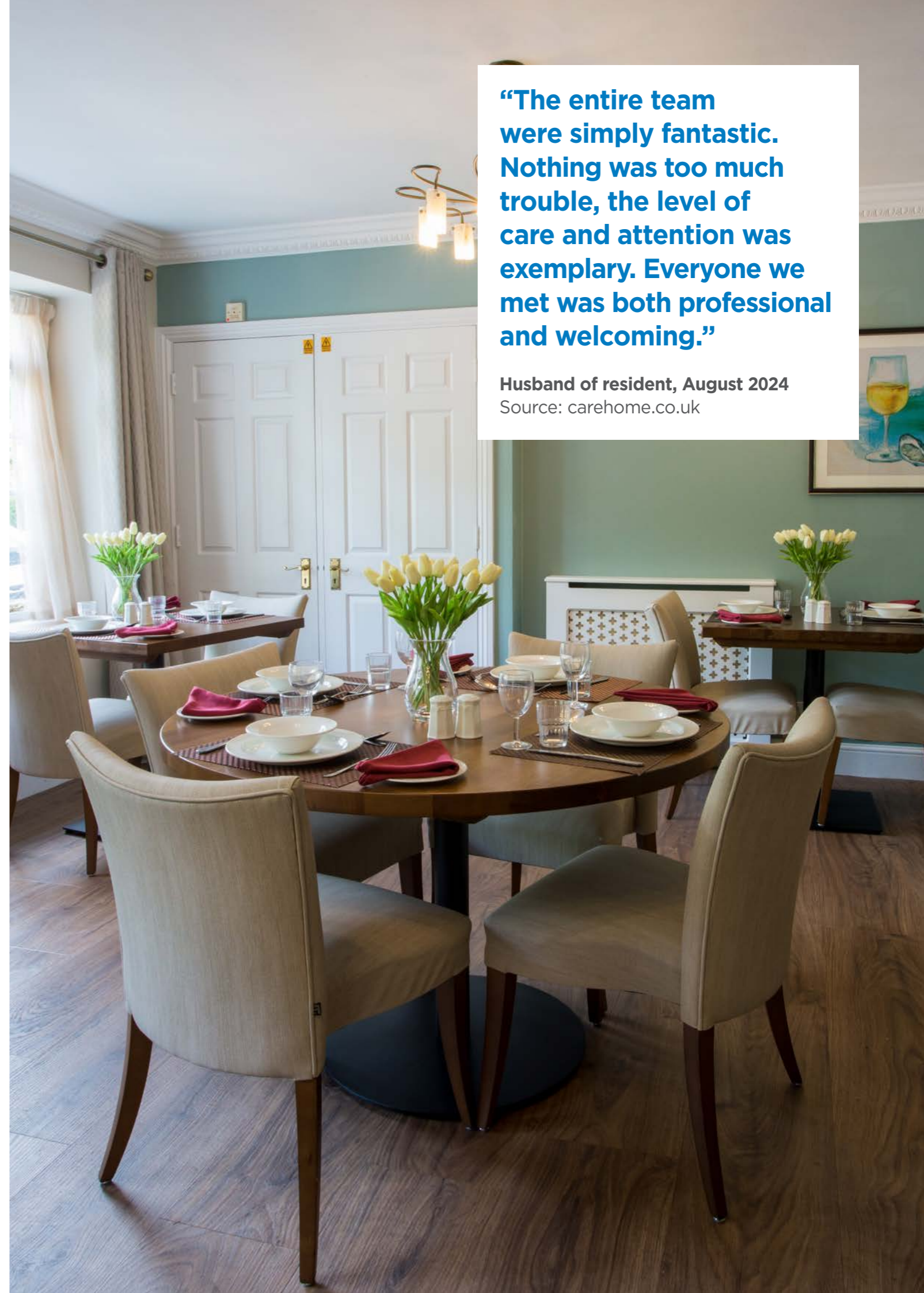
