The team is led by the registered manager of the home and the deputy manager. Both are registered nurses and have a wealth of experience to offer the team at The Langston. Together they lead a team of registered nurses, senior support workers, support workers, kitchen staff, housekeeping staff, maintenance and gardening staff who all work well together to ensure everyone who lives or stays at The Langston enjoys life to the full.

A high level of training is essential to ensure all staff at The Langston stay up to date in current development. Apart from the nurses, most of the care staff have reached their QCF Level 2 or 3.

Our facilities

All rooms are individually decorated to ensure a warm and restful environment. We place great importance on each person feeling at home. Residents are welcome to bring as much or as little furniture as they wish.

Our lounges are varied. We have a large lounge where everyone tends to meet during activities, next to the dining area. There is a second lounge where the residents can sit if they prefer a quieter area.

The home has an open and accessible court yard garden where residents are able to walk at their leisure and we have plans to landscape the garden area in the future.

Many bedrooms have a wonderful view and there is a choice of rooms with en suite facilities. Each bedroom has a 24 hour nurse call to hand. We liaise with members of the multi disciplinary team including physiotherapy, chiropody and GP surgeries on your behalf to maintain continuity of care.

Regular home comforts like newspapers, television, radio and other such facilities are also available and we have a separate hair salon.

Our history and location

The Langston was built by the Earl of Ducie as a hunting lodge with stabling for forty horses in the 1870's. It later became a hotel. In 1985 it was changed into a residential home. It was chosen because of its beautiful setting with lovely views over the Cotswolds in all directions and for the character of the building. Located within a few miles of the home are Chipping Norton, Stow-on-the-Wold, Bourton-on-the-Water and Churchill village.
