Your Questions

What times do you start and finish in the evening?

Usually, we start visiting clients at about 7am, and finish at about 10pm. If you have any specific requirements, however, please let us know and we'll do our best to accommodate you. We also offer night time support and live-in care.

What checks are in place when employing care professionals?

Our Quality System demands that we undertake comprehensive checks on all our care professionals. GoodOaks thoroughly checks and trains every person we employ. Enhanced criminal record checks, DBS 'barred list checks', thorough interviews and at least two work references are all used to make sure we, and you, are confident that the people helping you are suitable.

Can my care professional accompany me on visits outside my home?

Yes. Most of our care professionals drive, and have business insurance on their cars. They can take you shopping, to friends, to a doctor or hospital appointment, wherever you need to go. We ask that you pay mileage. If there are any parking fees, you will need to cover them as well.
