

#### Activities

Our coordinator plans a wide variety of activities for our residents to enjoy, including those who are less mobile. For example:

- piano sing-a-long sessions
- walks in the park
- cinema club with ice creams
- regular shopping trips
- gentle armchair exercises
- weekly quizzes
- visiting entertainers such as singers and dancers



Residents can still do most of their existing hobbies here. And they can always suggest something they'd like to try, as a group or in their room.

Our chef prepares delicious meals and snacks for our residents to enjoy in the social dining area or in the comfort of their own room.

We're happy to set aside a quiet area for small family events such as birthday parties. We'll just need to know in advance. Plus, we can arrange catering for an additional fee.




