Worthington Lake Care Home is a beautiful home overlooking the centre of the Standish Care Village, Worthington Lakes and associated woodlands.

A large garden space, outdoor exercise equipment, a private pathway to a local lake, and its own saloon bar means there's always something to do. But with several communal spaces and living rooms there is always time to sit down and relax.

The first home within the Millennium Care Group to operate a Household Model of Care, an innovative approach that has seen life expectancy rise for its residents.

Worthington is known for its activity provisions with a mantra of nothing is impossible – flying planes, scuba diving and an off road mobility scooter have allowed residents to age with vibrancy.



STANDISH CARE VILLAGE

The Standish Care Village is a unique setting in the North West, providing a continuity of care like no other in the region which creates a home for life.

Catering for respite, residential, nursing, and dementia care, those who move into a home within the Village have the security to know they will always have a home, and the relationships they create will continue to flourish under the same Millennium Care ethos.

All homes within the Village, Langtree, Lakeside and Worthington Lake, have private access to a local lake nestled within the Douglas Valley. Specialised staff support the daily needs of the residents and include a Music Ambassador and an Occupational Therapist.

The Village is centred around community, not only the strong connections and shared learning between the homes, but also the connection to the surrounding communities.



WHAT MAKES US DIFFERENT?

THE SETTING

The location of the home ensures that those who live with us are connected to nature and its seasons, bringing serendipity and spontaneity to individual, communal and social interactions.

A private pathway to Worthington Lakes with an off-road scooter means no one is left behind, whether it is a lakeside picnic, fishing or to watch the seasons change from the water's edge.

We encourage residents to bring their wellies, a rain jacket, umbrella and sunhat!

HOUSEHOLD MODEL

The building's architecture has been thoughtfully designed based on evidence-backed principles, ensuring that those who live with us do so in small clusters so they can profit from the environment's powerful but subtle therapeutic benefits.

This enables us to adopt a household model of care, with small group living to reduce stress, open-plan spaces that support independent wayfinding, and social areas centred around the dining experience because we believe the kitchen is often the heart of the home.

FOOD

Our food offering is as homely as it is wholesome. Through a deep understanding of ingredients and their alignment with gut and cognitive health, our vision is to create a daily dining experience that tastes as good as it makes you feel.

This journey starts with our skilled Kitchen Team carefully selecting all of our food ensuring it is fresh and sourced locally then through seasonally designed menus, a relaxed and none institutional approach to dining and ample opportunities for those who live and visit us to snack, graze and enjoy the pleasure and delight of food as a social activity.

ARTS

Each floor features a piano for spontaneous music with a music and art therapy suite overlooking the garden. Our in-house Music Ambassador, specially trained by the Manchester Camerata, offers a unique approach to dementia therapy.

WELLNESS

The home's Activity Coordinator gets to know the residents, creating tailored sessions and activities to encourage movement, socialising, positivity and enjoyment.

FITNESS & MOVEMENT

An accessible outdoor gym ensures all at Worthington are supported by regular movement. A perfect combination of physiotherapy and fitness, joining the mind and body in unison.

The Group's Occupational Therapist plays a vital role in supporting residents' independence, safety and quality of life. Improving mobility makes a huge impact on those with dementia needs.

NATURE

Studies have shown that access to green spaces and natural views helps people live longer, healthier, and happier lives. The home overlooks open fields, offering views of migrating birds, changing tree colours, and stunning sunsets, encouraging positive risk-taking in the outdoors; whatever the season.
